From MMN: "'Tell me the weight of a snowflake,' a robin asked a dove. "'Nothing more than nothing,' was the answer.

"In that case, I must tell you a marvelous story,' the robin said.

"I sat on the branch of a fir tree, close to its trunk, when it began to snow, not heavily, not in a raging blizzard, no, just like in a dream, without any violence.
